for some historians and biographers maximilien robespierre 1758 94 was a great revolutionary martyr who succeeded in leading the french republic to safety in the face of overwhelming military odds for many others he was the first modern dictator a fanatic who instigated the murderous reign of terror in 1793 94 this masterful biography combines new research into robespierre s dramatic life with a deep understanding of society and the politics of the french revolution to arrive at a fresh understanding of the

man his passions and his tragic shortcomings peter mcphee gives special attention to robespierre s formative years and the development of an iron will in a frail boy conceived outside wedlock and on the margins of polite provincial society exploring how these experiences formed the young lawyer who arrived in versailles in 1789 the author discovers not the cold obsessive robespierre of legend but a man of passion with close but platonic friendships with women soon immersed in revolutionary conflict he suffered increasingly lengthy periods of nervous collapse correlating with moments of political crisis yet robespierre was tragically unable to step away from the crushing burdens of leadership did his ruthless uncompromising exercise of power reflect a descent into madness in his final year of life mcphee reevaluates the ideology and reality of the terror what robespierre intended and whether it represented an abandonment or a reversal of his early liberalism and sense of justice

women played a major part in the french revolution of 1789 but have received very little recognition for their contributions the many claims and protests put forth by women at that time were suppressed women s clubs were banned and olympe de gouges a leading contemporary advocate for women s rights was silenced and has since remained an obscure figure this book is the first biography of this astonishing woman after boldly publishing her declaration of the rights of woman and of the female citizen in 1791 de gouges was sent to the guillotine for having had the courage to mount the rostrum on behalf of women unlike many who have captured posterity s attention de gouges had

great sympathy but no indulgence for her sex instead of considering her female colleagues as eternal victims she understood that they were to some extent responsible for their misfortunes and that if they united and devoted themselves to changing their image they could become great de gouges called for the advent of a new woman one who would relinquish the nocturnal administering of men olympe de gouges rightly deserves the title of pioneer prophet and heroine this long overdue biography pays her due homage it will be of interest to students of the french revolution women s studies and biography

a new york review books original victor serge is one of the great men of the 20th century and one of its great writers too he was an anarchist an agitator a revolutionary an exile a historian of his times as well as a brilliant novelist and in memoirs of a revolutionary he devotes all his passion and genius to describing this extraordinary and exemplary career serge tells of his upbringing among exiles and conspirators of his involvement with the notorious bonnot gang and his years in prison of his role in the russian revolution and of the revolution s collapse into despotism and terror expelled from the soviet union serge went to paris where he evaded the kgb and the nazis before fleeing to mexico memoirs of a revolutionary recounts a thrilling life on the front lines of history and includes vivid portraits not only of trotsky lenin and stalin but of countless other figures who struggled to remake the world peter sedgwick s fine translation of memoirs of a revolutionary was abridged when first published in 1963 this is the first edition in english to present the entirety of serge s book

biography of a hacienda is a book that will last for generations it looks at the real lives of real people pushed to the brink of revolution and its conclusions compel us to rethink the social and economic factors involved in the mexican revolution

afeni shakur one of the most visible figures in both the hip hop and civil rights movements reveals her moral and spiritual development in an innovative memoir spanning four decades before becoming one of the most well known members of the

black power movement alice faye williams was not unlike any other poor african american girl growing up in the impoverished south but when her family moved to new york during the radical sixties she became intoxicated by the promise of social change by the time she turned twenty one alice had a new name afeni shakur derived from the yoruba term for lover of people and a new vision for the future the rest is history in 1969 afeni was arrested along with other members of the black panther party on 189 felony charges that included 30 counts of conspiracy though she was eventually acquitted of the charges afeni spent eleven months in jail before being released once on bail she became pregnant with a son tupac amaru shakur a rap megastar until his tragic death in 1996 in this searing work renowned actress and afeni s trusted friend jasmine guy reveals the evolution of a woman through a series of intimate conversations on themes such as love death race drugs politics music and of course her son filled with startling revelations and heartbreaking truths afeni s memoir is a powerful testament to the human spirit and the perseverance of the african american people

although spain was never a formal ally of the united states during the american revolution its entry into the war definitively tipped the balance against britain led by bernardo de galvez supreme commander of the spanish forces in north america their military campaigns against british settlements on the mississippi river and later against mobile and pensacola were crucial in preventing britain from concentrating all its north american military and naval forces on the fight against george washington s continental army in this first comprehensive biography of galvez 1746 86 gonzalo m quintero saravia assesses the commander s considerable historical impact and expands our understanding of spain s contribution to the war a man of both empire and the enlightenment as viceroy of new spain 1785 86 galvez was also pivotal in the design and implementation of spanish colonial reforms which included the reorganization of spain s northern frontier that brought peace to the region for the duration of the spanish presence in north america extensively researched through spanish mexican and u s archives quintero saravia s portrait of galvez reveals him as central to the histories of the revolution and

late eighteenth century america and offers a reinterpretation of the international factors involved in the american war for independence

the battles of trenton and princeton have been the subject of several recent books but this story complements them by expanding the story to include the many experiences of the people of princeton in the wider revolution and their contributions to it this story combines social history with the better known military and political history of the revolution it does not just deal with amorphous groups and institutions but rather with individuals working with and affected by various groups on both sides of the conflict readers can identify with real people they get to know in the story this story of princeton unfolds in narrative format and while deeply researched reads more like a novel than an academic study

in early 20th century england aleister crowley 1875 1947 was considered the wickedest man in the world today he s seen as a prophet a master of the occult and a spiritual pioneer and his reputation just keeps on growing this new biography written with the cooperation of leading crowley scholars and including new revelations from crowley s grandson displays the full scope of the man s many achievements as poet explorer

spiritualist wartime spy and a thinker as significant as jung freud or einstein

this vividly detailed revisionist history opens a new vista on the great ottoman empire in the early nineteenth century a key period often seen as the eve of tanzimat westernizing reforms and the beginning of three distinct histories ethnic nationalism in the balkans imperial modernization from istanbul and european colonialism in the middle east christine philliou brilliantly shines a new light on imperial crisis and change in the 1820s and 1830s by unearthing the life of one man stephanos vogorides 1780 1859 was part of a network of christian elites known phanariots institutionally excluded from power yet intimately bound up with ottoman governance by tracing the contours of the wide ranging networks crossing ethnic religious and institutional boundaries in which the phanariots moved philliou provides a unique view of ottoman power and ultimately of the ottoman legacies in the middle east and balkans today what emerges is a wide angled analysis of governance as a lived experience at a moment in which there was no clear blueprint for power

identity politics is everywhere polarizing discourse from the campaign trail to the classroom and amplifying antagonisms in the media both online and off but the compulsively referenced phrase bears little resemblance to the concept as first introduced by the radical black feminist combahee river collective while the collective articulated a political viewpoint grounded in their own position as black lesbians with the explicit aim of building solidarity across lines of difference identity politics is now frequently weaponized as a means of closing ranks around ever narrower conceptions of group interests but the trouble oldid mi o tddefly argues is not with identity politics itself through a substantive engagement with the global black radical tradition and a critical understanding of racial capitalism tddefly identifies the process by which a radical concept can be stripped of its political substance and liberatory potential by becoming the victim of elite capture deployed by political social and economic elites in the service of their own interests tddefly scrucial intervention both elucidates this complex process and helps us move beyond a binary of class vs race by rejecting elitist

identity politics in favor of a constructive politics of radical solidarity he advances the possibility of organizing across our differences in the urgent struggle for a better world

celebrates the life and work of the first democratically elected leader in 1 000 years of russian history who presided over the disintegration of the soviet empire and the move to a free market economy

zhou in china are heavily censored and every hint of criticism is removed so when gao wenqian first published this groundbreaking provocative biography in hong kong it was immediately banned in the people s republic using classified documents spirited out of china gao wenqian offers an objective human portrait of the real zhou a man who lived his life at the heart of chinese politics for fifty years who survived both the long march and the cultural revolution not thanks to ideological or personal purity but because he was artful crafty and politically supple he may have had the looks of a matinee idol and nixon may have called him the greatest statesman of our era but zhou s greatest gift was to survive at almost any price thanks to his acute understanding of where political power resided at any one time

a major new biography of a man of humble origins who became one of the great military leaders of the american revolution on january 17 1781 at cowpens south carolina the notorious british cavalry officer banastre tarleton and his legion had been destroyed along with the cream of lord cornwallis s troops the man who planned and executed this stunning american victory was daniel morgan once a barely literate backcountry laborer morgan now stood at the pinnacle of american martial success born in new jersey in 1736 he left home at seventeen and found himself in virginia s shenandoah valley there he worked in mills and as a teamster and was recruited for braddock s disas trous expedition to take fort duquesne from the french in 1755 when george washington called for troops to join him at the siege of boston in 1775 morgan organized a select group of riflemen and headed north from that moment on morgan s presence made an immediate impact on the battlefield and on his superiors washington soon recognized morgan s leadership and tactical abilities when morgan s troops blocked the british retreat at saratoga in 1777 ensuring an american victory he received accolades from across the colonies in daniel morgan a revolutionary life the first biogra phy of this iconic figure in forty years historian albert louis zambone presents morgan as the quintessential american everyman who rose through his own dogged determination from poverty and obscurity to become one of the great battlefield commanders in american history using social history and other advances in the discipline that had not been available to earlier biographers the author provides an engrossing portrait of this storied per sonality of america's founding era a common man in uncommon times
